To ensure its longevity and maintain its beautiful appearance, it is important to follow these care and cleaning instructions. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product.

GETTING STARTED

For the best cleaning & care results when maintaining your Morzze products, please follow all instructions carefully, and only use the suggested cleaning agents. Using other cleaning agents may cause damage or discoloration and may potentially affect the functionality of your product.

Always test all cleaning agents on an inconspicuous area of your Morzze product before applying to the entire surface.

Wipe all surfaces clean and rinse them completely with water immediately after applying the cleaner. Rinse and dry any excess cleaner that may land on adjacent surfaces. Do not allow cleaner to sit, as it may soak in and cause damage.

Use a soft, damp cloth or sponge. **DO NOT** use any abrasive material, such as a scouring pad, brush, or steel wool, to clean the surface of your Morzze product.

The effectiveness of all cleaners depends on factors like water hardness and temperature, consistency of cleaning formulas, and age/condition of the product being cleaned. Variations in these, and other, factors mean that Morzze cannot guarantee the effectiveness of any cleaner or procedure used. Please see the product warranty for further details on what is covered under normal conditions of use.

Proper care and maintenance of your kitchen Drain Pipes are essential to ensure optimal performance and prevent clogs. Follow these guidelines to keep your drain pipes clean and functioning efficiently:

RECOMMENDED USE & CARE:

Use a Sink Strainer Cover: Place a sink strainer cover over or inside your drain to catch food particles and debris. This helps prevent clogs by trapping waste that should go in the trash, not the drain.

Avoid Pouring Grease or Oil: Never pour grease, fat, or oil down the drain. As they cool, they solidify and cause blockages. Instead, pour them into a container and dispose of it in the trash.

Watch What Goes Down the Drain: Certain items like eggshells, small bones, coffee grounds, and vegetable peels should never be put down the drain or garbage disposal. These materials can easily cause clogs over time.

Unclogging the Drain:

- **Boiling Water:** If your pipes are metal, pour boiling water down the drain to dissolve minor blockages.
 - **Vinegar and Baking Soda:** Pour a mixture of vinegar and baking soda down the drain. Let it sit for 5 minutes, then flush with boiling water. This natural method can help break up clogs.
 - **Plunging:** Use a plunger to loosen clogs just as you would in a toilet. Make sure the plunger fully covers the drain for maximum effect.
- Regular Cleaning: Pour boiling water down metal pipes every few weeks to remove buildup. You can also use vinegar to eliminate bacteria and Odors, ensuring the water flows smoothly.

When to Call a Professional: If clogs persist or your sink drains slowly, it may be a sign of a deeper issue. Contact a plumber for professional assistance if needed.

Following these care and maintenance tips will help keep your kitchen drain pipes running smoothly for years to come.
