To ensure its longevity and maintain its beautiful appearance, it is important to follow these care and cleaning instructions. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product.

### GETTING STARTED

For the best cleaning & care results when maintaining your Morzze products, please follow all instructions carefully, and only use the suggested cleaning agents. Using other cleaning agents may cause damage or discoloration and may potentially affect the functionality of your product.

Always test all cleaning agents on an inconspicuous area of your Morzze product before applying to the entire surface.

Wipe all surfaces clean and rinse them completely with water immediately after applying the cleaner. Rinse and dry any excess cleaner that may land on adjacent surfaces. Do not allow cleaner to sit, as it may soak in and cause damage.

Use a soft, damp cloth or sponge. DO NOT use any abrasive material, such as a scouring pad, brush, or steel wool, to clean the surface of your Morzze product.

The effectiveness of all cleaners depends on factors like water hardness and temperature, consistency of cleaning formulas, and age/condition of the product being cleaned. Variations in these, and other, factors mean that Morzze cannot guarantee the effectiveness of any cleaner or procedure used. Please see the product warranty for further details on what is covered under normal conditions of use.

To keep your sink strainer functioning at its best, it is important to properly care for and clean it regularly. Here are some care and cleaning instructions for your sink strainer:



### **RECOMMENDED USE & CARE:**

Regular Cleaning: Sink strainer should be cleaned regularly to prevent buildup of dirt, grime, and water spots. Simply use a mild dish soap or a non-abrasive cleaner and hot water to wipe down the surface of the sink strainer. Rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with a clean cloth.

**Dry Thoroughly:** After each use, make sure to dry the sink strainer thoroughly with a clean cloth. This will prevent water spots and mineral deposits from forming on the surface of the drainer.

**Use a Stainless Steel Cleaner:** For tougher stains or to restore shine to the sink strainer, use a specialized stainless steel cleaner. When purchasing a cleaner for your floor drainer, look for a brand that explicitly states its products are "suitable for stainless steel". We recommend using your choice of cleaner from the Products to Consider section below.

**Use a Soft Cloth:** When cleaning stainless steel sink strainer, always use a soft cloth or sponge to prevent scratching the surface. Avoid using steel wool, abrasive pads, or harsh scrub brushes.

#### Please Be Aware That:

Avoid Harsh Cleaners: Avoid using harsh chemicals, bleach, ammonia, toilet cleaners, acid, chlorine or abrasive cleaners on sink strainer as they can damage the surface of the sink strainer. Instead, opt for gentle or natural cleaners for safe and effective cleaning.

Do not leave acidic or alkaline substances on the drain surface: Stainless steel can react with acidic or alkaline substances and cause discoloration

or damage to the floor drainer. Avoid leaving lemon juice, vinegar, or bleach on the drain surface for extended periods.

#### Note

• Unfortunately, stainless steel will scratch over time. This is inherent to the material; you will see evidence of this wear condition on the surface of other steel items, such as cutlery, and pots & pans. For this reason, we recommend that you use the mildest form of cleaner available. Please use a non-abrasive cleaning soap (e.g. liquid dishwasher detergent) with a soft cloth to clean the surface.

• Mineral deposits build up over time, so we recommend using vinegar to neutralize the calcium deposits. Use a soft dishcloth saturated with vinegar to scrub the surface, then rinse with water and towel dry.

Following these care and cleaning instructions will help to keep your sink strainer looking clean and shiny for years to come. With regular maintenance, your drainer will stay in top condition and continue to be a beautiful and functional part of your bathroom.
